## THE PASTOR'S DESK A MESSAGE FROM FATHER PETER

#### Father's Day

We may be a week behind but allow me to express my gratitude to our priests, deacons and lay people for their earnest participation in our Corpus Christi Procession! We were encouraged in the spirit of the eucharistic revival promoted by our bishops to carry out a procession; it was a most welcome experience. Spiritually it was like a much-needed tonic: getting outside the church environment and out into the everyday world of family, neighbors, jobs and school, etc. It was not political but celebratory. We simply wanted to have a moment to tell the world about our joyful faith in Jesus and particularly his Real Presence to his people in the Eucharist. I am confident that the procession through the neighborhood will be a true revival moment. I think our highpoint will be a pilgrimage to the American Marsyas in October! We will talk about that later. In the meantime, may we enjoy the good memories of our procession in the streets.


In the Gospel today we hear Jesus say to his disciples, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send laborers for his harvest."



"Many hands make light work!"



Fatherhood has its origins in God, who chose to reveal Himself to us as Our Father, sending his only Son for the sake of our salvation. Fathers therefore have a special role "in revealing and in reliving on earth the very fatherhood of God" (Familiaris consortio 25). Indeed, the role of the father "is of unique and irreplaceable importance" (FC 25). Although society increasingly tells fathers that they have no say in the lives of their children before birth and fails to recognize the dynamic and critically important role of fatherhood, it is both a biological and spiritual reality. Pope Saint John Paul II said fathers are called to exhibit "generous responsibility for the life conceived under the heart of the mother" (FC 25). They are uniquely entrusted with the protection and defense of both mother and child and, in this way, in safeguarding the sanctity of human life. Yet research continues to show that the top reasons women seek abortions include lacking support from the child's father and financial challenges, which are only exacerbated by a father's absence. As a Church community, we need to encourage and support men to follow the example of St. Joseph and embrace their various roles as father. Even if a man is not a parent, he is still called to spiritual fatherhood—a fatherhood that fosters others' relationship with God, protecting them from evil and providing an example of Christ's love. St. Joseph, himself, was unexpectedly called to both practical and spiritual fatherhood, and amid very difficult circumstances. But despite all obstacles, Joseph was faithful. He welcomed life, offering care and protection to Mary and Jesus. We pray that each expectant father will find courage in the example of St. Joseph and offer loving, lifeaffirming support to the mother of his child.
