Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

TUESDAY, AUGUST 15, 2023

The Feast of the Assumption is a Holy Day of Obligation. We commemorate that Mary, the mother of Jesus Christ, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory, rather than go through the natural process of physical decay upon death. This feast day has been celebrated in the Church since the fourth century. In 1950, Pope Pius XII declared this to be official dogma of the Roman Catholic Church.


