

A downpour started our Friday morning departure without dampening our spirits; by 3:30pm, the hour of mercy, sunshine greeted us at St. Kateri Tekakwitha's baptismal chapel in humble Fonda, NY. As the hostess of our journey, Our Lady provided a great dinner, comfortable rooms, and an excellent bus driver. Saturday was filled with an inspiring procession of clergy into the coliseum church for Holy Mass celebrated at the main altar.
