LIVING STEWARDSHIP PILLAR OF PRAYER



Perhaps you can offer to take an elderly friend to Mass or to the grocery store (or even do their shopping for them). Perhaps you can just be an ear for someone who needs to talk.

THE PASTOR'S DESK

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER PETER

"Now is the acceptable time; now is the day of salvation!" The prophet Isaiah tells us clearly – This is not a request; this is a Proclamation!

We may not be ready, but Lent is ready for us! Thoughts of Penance, Sin, Ashes, extra Prayer, etc. may be far from our spontaneous thoughts, but the prophet tells us get started somewhere, anywhere. Let's be humble enough to tell the Lord "I'm only good for a grade six, a nine or ten would be over my head." The big three of Lent: Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving come into play. You can be creative here: Fast from Gossip! Pray with a child, help a challenged person complete a task.



Lent is not about struggling, but about growing in a relationship with Jesus who is a lot more excited about growing closer to us. Finally, check in about your Lent with another person who is passionate about Lent. We can all – young and old – help each other in the challenges of the holy unconventional but blessed season!


